## Trigonal Chess

Trigonal Chess is a recent member in a family of similar chess variants played on triangular fields. The new board orientation and simple rules make the suggested game a perfect choice for a fun play with your friends, and open new dimensions of unexplored spaces. 10

Instruction:

a. Cut and glue together three board parts to make a regular triangle made of 81 smaller triangles. Glue it onto a piece of cardboard. b. Cut the included right orientated symbolic pieces and glue them onto a piece of cardboard. Then cut the left orientated pieces and glue them as the reverse opposites of their analogues. c. Use included black stripes to cower the board's corners

in a smooth way.

d. Use the Scotch tape to cover the board and pieces.
